Trials to be held indoors (air conditioned facility) at Seelah Kennel and Training Center, Adel, Iowa Trial Limit- 125 runs per day total all events

Show Hours—Saturday and Sunday 7:15 a.m. to the end of the trial

Pre-entries will be accepted on a "first received" basis **beginning Wed, March 2, 2016.** No entries accepted prior this date. Pre-entries will **close Monday, April 4** or when entry limits have been met. A wait list will be kept if trial fills. Day of Entries will close day of trial at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, or when entry limits have been reached, at which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in UKC Dog Show Rules

A fee of \$40.00 will be levied for a returned check . All entries must be submitted on Official UKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and will not be entered in the trial. FAX'd entries and/or credit card payments cannot be accepted. Entries sent by overnight mail must not require a signature. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the show committee or UKC. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial minus a \$5.00 handling fee with a veterinarian's certificate prior to the start of the trial.

Trial Information- Notice to Exhibitors

A UKC PT or NACSW ORT is required for entry in a UKC element title trial for the level/odorentered. Copy of PT or ORT should be sent with entry.

For pre-entries if you do not pass the required PT test in the morning the club will refund you the entry fees that were pre-paid. This is to encourage pre-entries.

Novice A is open to any handler that has not earned a nosework title in any organization and is not a nosework judge or nosework instructor.

Handlers are only allowed to run 1 dog per PT or Element level. (Example 1 dog in novice and 1 in advanced).

A UKC registration number is required to participate in these trials. For information on UKC registration go to <u>www.ukcdogs.com</u>.

Crating space will not be available indoors and handlers will need to plan to work from vehicles.

Food will not be available for purchase onsite. Please plan accordingly.



Awards and Prizes:

Placement ribbons will be provided for 1-4 placements in each class. Blue qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Ribbon will be provided for High in Trial each trial and High Junior. New title ribbons will be offered for anyone earning titles.

Physical address: 2955 R Avenue, Adel, IA

From the North or South: Interstate 35/80 to the Hickman Road exit (US Highway 6, exit 125). West approximately 10 miles to County Road R-16. South (left) on R-16 ¹/₄ mile. Training Center is on the right.

From the East or West: US Highway 6 to County Road R-16 (approximately 10 miles West of the Interstate 35/80 bridge), then South ¹/₄ mile. Or, Interstate 80 to Van Meter exit (#113) then North 4 miles. Seelah is on the left before reaching US Highway 6.
